FINAL DETERMINATION OF DEPARTMENT

In accordance with the Michigan Medical Marihuana Act (Initiated Law 1 of 2008) and 2009 AACS, R 333.131, two petitions were filed with the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs to consider adding autism as a qualifying disease or medical condition to the list of debilitating medical conditions under 2009. AACS, R 333.101.

After discussion and public hearing, on August 6, 2013, the Medical Marihuana Review Panel voted on a motion to approve autism as a qualifying condition. The motion failed with a vote of 2 yes votes and 7 no votes. Pursuant to 2009 AACS, R 333.131(4), "a quorum of the review panel shall concur with the recommendation in order to be considered an official recommendation of the panel."

As a quorum of the review panel did not concur in the recommendation, the petitions to add autispy to the Jist of debilitating conditions are denied.
