## **Maximum THC Concentrations for Marijuana-Infused Products**

The intent of this technical bulletin is to release the list of maximum THC concentrations for marijuana-infused products.

## Rule 4 in the Marijuana-Infused Products and Edible Marijuana Product Rule Set – R 420.404

A marijuana sales location shall not sell or transfer marijuana-infused products that exceed the maximum THC concentrations established by the agency by more than 10%. For the purposes of maximum THC concentrations for marijuana-infused products, the agency shall publish a list of maximum THC concentrations and serving size limits.

Products not listed	10 mg	100 mg
